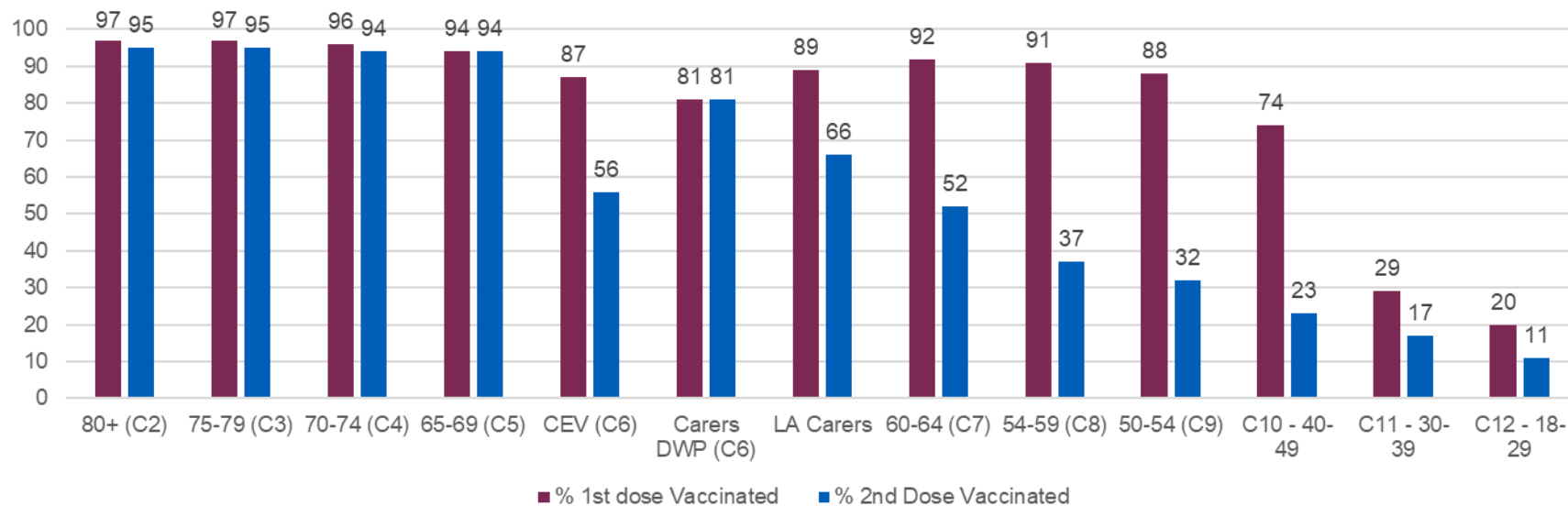


COVID-19 vaccination programme May 2021 update

Cornwall and Isles of Scilly vaccinations complete by cohort as of 19 May 2021



- 342,000 first doses and 201,000 second doses completed.
- On track to meet national target to have offered eligible population first dose by 1 July scenario planning for autumn.
- Additional capacity in place to support requirement for accelerated second doses for cohorts 1 to 9.
- Cohort 1 to 10 now eligible and those over 36-year-olds (start of cohort 11).
- Fifth pharmacy in county starts vaccination clinics in Newquay on 24 May.
- Plans in place to transfer Moderna vaccine to Isles of Scilly to ensure under 40s can be offered alternative to Oxford Astra Zeneca.
- Targeted and bespoke work continues to offer vaccines to harder to reach groups including pop-up clinics to support migrant worker communities at their place of work, people who are homeless, people with mental health and substance misuse problems and people with learning disabilities.

- NHS App now acts as vaccination record to those travelling abroad.
